Optional activity: download a set of Greek fonts from the internet -- or use already installed ones -- and type in Greek the above sentence from John 1:1. Experiment with how the particular Greek font set you're using handles the accent and breathing marks as overstrike characters. Different font sets work differently at this point. One word of caution for those using the Word Perfect software: typing overstrike characters such as accent and breathing marks is especially difficult and sometimes impossible with certain TrueType Greek fonts. Lotus Word Pro and Microsoft Word handle these special font sets much better. Also, don't waste your time trying to make sense out of the Word Perfect Greek Fonts that come with the software. They are a very poor quality font set and create nightmares in trying to do accents and breathing marks. Any of the free shareware Greek font sets from the Linguistics Gateway web site will be much easier to use and much better quality.
