The Significance of This Baptismal Service

In Baptist heritage and tradition, baptism, as taught by God's Word, is a public confession of one's personal faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. Thus, only one old enough to personally profess faith can be baptized scripturally. As such it must be by immersion of candidates in water and be administered by an ordained minister acting under the authorization of a local congregation. As one of the two church ordinances commanded by Jesus to His followers, baptism pictures the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ as the basis of one's hope of salvation. Additionally it symbolizes to the individual death to the old life, the laying aside of that life in burial, and the spiritual resurrection to new life in Christ. With one's baptism as a profession of faith in Christ, membership in a local congregation then is granted by the church.

Linda and Henry thus confess their faith in Christ as Savior and Lord in this service. We, the members of the International Baptist Convention church of Cologne, welcome Linda and Henry into full membership in our church on the basis of their baptism. We pledge to them our prayers, encouragement and support as they seek to serve Christ through the ministries of our congregation.
