

In the early 1600s a group of religious refugees from England gathered in the back room of an Amsterdam bakery to pray and study the Bible together. By 1609 a group of them had formed what we have come to know as core Baptist convictions, especially the necessity of a believers' church, separated from state control and practising believers' baptism. From these modest beginnings the Baptists spread through England, North America and Europe

and beyond to become a worldwide movement with a community of around 100 million members today.

European Baptists will celebrate this significant 400th anniversary in Amsterdam from 24-26 July, 2009 in the splendid surroundings of the RAI Centre in Amsterdam. Baptists do not only want to review their historical beginnings at this celebration event, but also seek to discern God's calling on them for the future. Like that first small group of believers in 1609 they will be challenged to 'dare to be different' as they face the challenges of today's secularised society as Christian believers.

The Amsterdam 400 conference provides a unique opportunity for the EBF family to come together in larger numbers for the first time since 1994. Inspiring speakers have been invited to draw on the past by exploring Baptists beginnings and yet help cast the EBF vision for the future. All this will be done in a context of lively worship which will draw on the full richness and variety of worship traditions within the EBF. The Amsterdam 400 event will also offer a full programme involving seminars, music, drama, and art. Focus areas will allow informal conversation and learning together on mission, religious freedom and human rights, theological education and Baptist history.

## Prayer List<sup>1</sup> IBC Baptist Church of Cologne as of 18 January 2009

He [Jesus] was teaching and saying, "Is it not written, "My house shall be called a house of prayer for all the nations"?" (Mark 11:17)

The following indicates individuals and situations that we as members of the International Baptist Church in Cologne need to be praying for daily.

- For possible mission projects next summer. The International Baptist Convention has entered into a partnership agreement with the Virginia Baptist Convention for joint mission ventures. Beginning conversations have taken place between Pastor Lorin and Craig Waddell, mission projects coordinator for the VBMB, about a mission group for sometime in June or July of 2009. Be much in prayer for God's guidance into how we can partner with Virginia Baptists in outreach activities to win people to Christ in our city.
- For Barbara Goodman and her two small sons. Her husband, Dan, was a New Testament professor colleague of Pastor Lorin's at Gardner-Webb University. Dan suddenly died of a heart attack on Tuesday, Jan. 13. Dan was 40 years old and in the early stages of becoming a significant Baptist New Testament professor in the United States.



- For former members of IBC church Cologne, that many of them will find God leading them to return to active service in our church. We rejoice over those whom God has led to reunite with our church already this fall.
- For national leaders around the world as they try to come to grips with the deepening economic troubles world wide. In the past such difficulties have often preceded major wars. Pray that God will intervene to give wisdom for solving these problems quickly and without violent conflict developing.
- For the world wide ministries of Christ to the World Ministries (CTTWM). Pastor Lorin has served for several years as biblical and theological editor, as well as writer, for this Texas based organization that broadcasts radio dramas and Bible studies to over 100 million people scattered all the way from Russia to China and Korea.
- For the Russian Christians and specifically for the Far East Broadcasting (FEBC). CTTWM
  recently received word from the FEBC National Director Rudi Wiens of growing concerns
  that he has over growing political tensions against evangelical Christianity.
- For several new projects currently underway by CTTWM: 1) radio broadcasts throughout Pakistan began on Oct. 30; 2) beginning broadcasts in the Hindi language, the 4th language throughout December in Mongolia; 3) preparations for teaching Chinese seminary students in nine cities over China during February 2009; 4) preparations for broadcasts of the gospel from Radio Sotak in Baghdad Iraq via the internet targeting the middle east; 6) for the recruiting of several more volunteers with experience in radio broadcast script
