Introduction

The chart on the reverse side represents the proposed operating budget for the fiscal year 2010 in our church and shows changes from the 2009 budget. Several observations are important to keep in mind.

- 1. The Church Finance Team sought to strike a balance between budget expansion and realistic expectation of contributions during 2010. Although we received 50.224,-- Euros in total contributions, some of this came as a one time donation, and already one member who gives large amounts has indicated the likelihood of substantial reduction in contributions during the second half of this year because of personal economic difficulties.
- 2. Consequently, the proposed budget represents a projected 17.34% growth in contributions over *projected* contributions in last year's budget. To be certain, actual contributions last year went beyond budget projections by almost 76%. Thus the new budget projects about a 12% reduction in contributions over last year. Of course, the hope and prayer is that growth in contributions will continue to outpace expenditures in 2010 as was true in 2009. But careful stewardship of God's finances necessitates realistic assessment of the situation and cautious planning based on that assessment.
- 3. The past history of the church in over committing itself to expenditures and then in getting itself into serious financial difficulties urges caution and careful management of the funds contributed to the church. The Church Finance Team is committed to this principle: "Expand but do so carefully, not recklessly."
- 4. The submitted budget requests from many of the Ministry Teams initially pushed the budget totals to close to 54,000 Euros. Consequently, trimming became necessary. This is always the most painful part of the budget planning process, and almost always is a necessity in budget planning. Careful balancing of requests from individual ministry teams against the overall expenditure totals was followed by the Church Finance Team in doing the reductions. Fairness to everyone was given serious attention.
- 5. In light of the searches for a new pastor and a new youth pastor currently underway, consideration of financial support for these positions had to be incorporated

into the new budget. To be certain, the financial support of neither of these individuals will constitute a 'full time' financial support. But the Church Finance Team felt it critically important to set up as much support as possible as a foundation for approaching prospective individuals about either pastor or youth pastor. This will communicate a clear signal to prospective candidates that the church is committed to supporting them in the ministry here to the widest extent possible. In both positions, the assumption is that supplementing the church's support from outside sources will be essential in order to have a livable income while serving the church. The hope and prayer is that over time the growth of the church in membership and financial contributions will enable the church to move closer to a 'full time' financial support of these two positions. But this is not yet feasible.

- 6. Consequently, the Church Finance Team makes the following recommendation regarding the Cost Centers related to financial support of the pastor and youth pastor. These cost centers are 200-2-1 (Pastor's Salary), 200-2-3 (Pastor's Insurance); 200-2-11 (Office Rent for Youth Pastor); and 200-2-10 (Honorarium for Youth Pastor). The designated amounts in these four categories, equaling 620 Euros monthly, would be placed in a interest bearing savings account at the Kölner Bank where our checking account is currently located. The funds would then be accumulating and could be used to help cover any costs incurred in moving a new pastor and a new youth pastor to the field of service here.
- 7. Some of the amounts listed earlier in the 2009 budget were incorrect and have been corrected in this report. Primarily, the earlier report did not include the increases brought about through the church's purchase of a car in October. To be best of our knowledge, the figures for 2009 in this report are accurate and represent a solid basis for comparison with the proposed budget for 2010.
- 8. The Church Leadership Team has gone over the budget and, in their meeting on Sunday, Feb. 21, voted to endorse the proposed budget with a recommendation that the church adopt the budget as proposed by the Church Finance Team.

Finally, I want to express appreciation for the work of the Church Finance Team in putting together this new budget proposal. The team members -- Francis Adoga, Kingsley Edosomwan, Edward Jikong and Alexandra Cürten -- did extensive work on Saturday, Feb. 13. As your pastor, I commend them for this excellent proposal and highly recommend it to you as well.
