- · Acts 13:4a
 - 13.4 So, being sent out by the Holy Spirit, they went down to Seleucia; and from there they sailed to Cyprus.
 - 13.4 Αὐτοὶ μὲν οὖν ἐκπεμφθέντες ὑπὸ τοῦ ἀγίου πνεύματος κατῆλθον εἰς Σελεύκειαν, ἐκεῖθέν τε ἀπέπλευσαν εἰς Κύπρον,

- Heavy Greek influence since Alexander
- Mentioned 8x either as Κύπος or Κύριος
- Large Jewish population
- Christianity preceded Paul 8
 Acts 11: 19-20





- 5.0.1.2 Salamis and beyond
- · Acts 13:5

When they arrived at Salamis, they proclaimed the word of God in the synagogues of the Jews.

καὶ γενόμενοι ἐν Σαλαμῖνι κατήγγελλον τὸν λόγον τοῦ θεοῦ ἐν ταῖς συναγωγαῖς τῶν Ἰουδαίων·

And they had John also to assist them.

είχον δὲ καὶ Ἰωάννην ὑπηρέτην.

- When they had gone through the whole island as far as Paphos, they met a certain magician, Parokarpaso Jewish false prophet, named Bar-Jesus, who was with the proconsul, Sergius Paulus, an intelligent man.



- · Acts 13:7b-8
- Sergius Paulus, an intelligent man, who summoned Barnabas and Saul and wanted to hear the word of God. But the magician Elymas (for that is the translation of his name) opposed them and tried to turn the proconsul away from the faith.
- οὖτος προσκαλεσάμενος Βαρναβᾶν καὶ Σαῦλον ἐπεζήτησεν ἀκοῦσαι τὸν λόγον τοῦ θεοῦ· 8 ἀνθίστατο δὲ αὐτοῖς Ἐλύμας ὁ μάγος, οὕτως γὰρ μεθερμηνεύεται τὸ ὄνομα αὐτοῦ, ζητῶν διαστρέψαι τὸν ἀνθύπατον ἀπὸ τῆς πίστεως.

- · Acts 13:9-11
- 9 But Saul, also known as Paul, filled with the Holy Spirit, looked intently at him 10 and said, "You son of the devil, you enemy of all righteousness, full of all deceit and villainy, will you not stop making crooked the straight paths of the Lord? 11 And now listen—the hand of the Lord is against you, and you will be blind for a while, unable to see the sun." Immediately mist and darkness came over him, and he went about groping for someone to lead him by the hand.

- When the proconsul saw what had happened, he believed, for he was astonished at the teaching about the Lord.
- τότε ἰδὼν ὁ ἀνθύπατος τὸ γεγονὸς ἐπίστευσεν ἐκπλησσόμενος ἐπὶ τῆ διδαχα τοῦ κυρίου.


