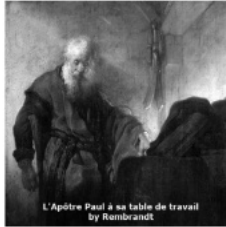

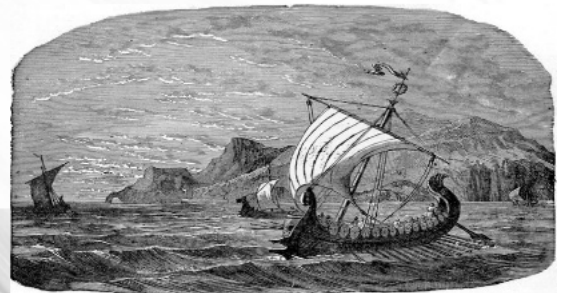

- **Acts 13:13**

- **13 Then Paul and his companions set sail from Paphos and came to Perga in Pamphylia. John, however, left them and returned to Jerusalem;**

- **13** Ἀναχθέντες δὲ ἀπὸ τῆς Πάφου οἱ περὶ Παῦλον ἦλθον εἰς Πέργην τῆς Παμφυλίας· Ἰωάννης δὲ ἀποχωρήσας ἀπ' αὐτῶν ὑπέστρεψεν εἰς Ἱεροσόλυμα.

- *Perga, sea port city*
- *First stop on the mainland*
- *John Mark left the group*

- **City 160 km north of Perga**

- **Elevation at 3,600 feet (about 1,200 meters)**

- **Much more Roman than Greek as outpost**

- **Administrative center for Galatia province**

- **Episodic narrative w. speech (16b-41)**

- **Narrative Introduction, vv. 14-16a**
- **14** but they went on from Perga and came to Antioch in Pisidia. And on the sabbath day they went into the synagogue and sat down. **15** After the reading of the law and the prophets, the officials of the synagogue sent them a message, saying, “Brothers, if you have any word of exhortation for the people, give it.” **16** So Paul stood up and with a gesture began to speak:
- **14** αὐτοὶ δὲ διελθόντες ἀπὸ τῆς Πέργης παρεγένοντο εἰς Ἀντιόχειαν τὴν Πισιδίαν, καὶ εἰσελθόντες εἰς τὴν συναγωγὴν τῆ ἡμέρα τῶν σαββάτων ἐκάθισαν. **15** μετὰ δὲ τὴν ἀνάγνωσιν τοῦ νόμου καὶ τῶν προφητῶν ἀπέστειλαν οἱ ἀρχισυναγωγοὶ πρὸς αὐτοὺς λέγοντες· ἄνδρες ἀδελφοί, εἴ τίς ἐστὶν ἐν ὑμῖν λόγος παρακλήσεως πρὸς τὸν λαόν, λέγετε. **16** ἀναστὰς δὲ Παῦλος καὶ κατασείσας τῆ χειρὶ εἶπεν·

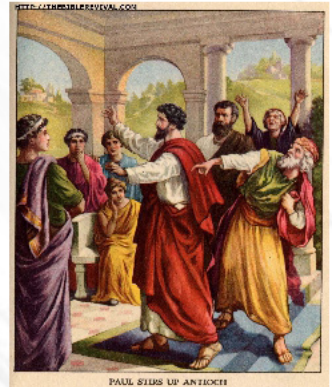
