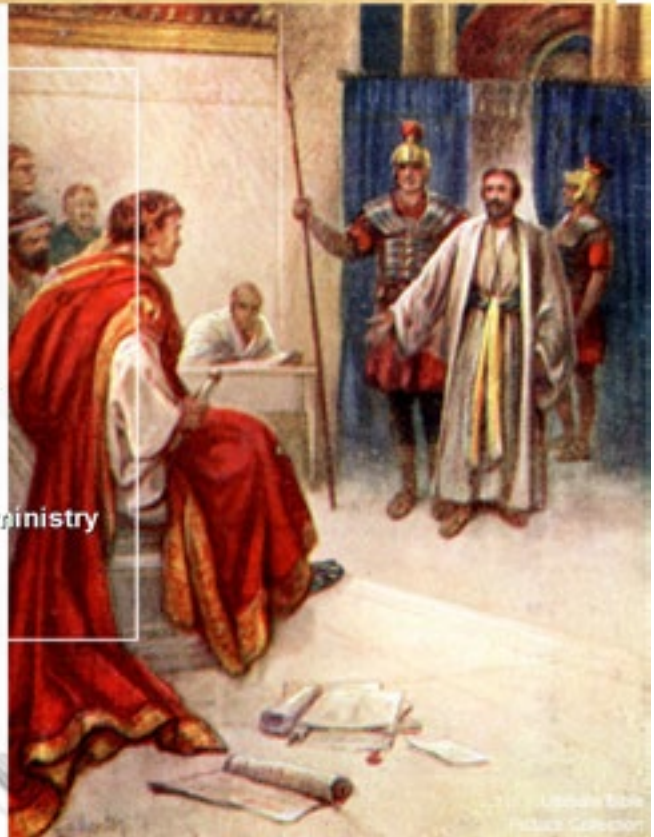

## The Apostle Paul, Servant of Christ

- **What can we learn from Paul's defense before Agrippa?**

- ✓ 1. Paul appropriately followed Greco-Roman protocol with his *captatio benevolentiae*
- ✓ 2. Paul presented his case to Agrippa clearly
- ✓ 3. Paul felt freedom to speak to one knowledgeable of the Jews
- ✓ 4. Paul encouraged Agrippa to pay close attention to his words
