## The Apostle Paul, Servant of Christ

- **What can we learn from Paul's defense before Agrippa?**

- ✓ 1. Paul obeyed the commands of Christ given to him (v. 19)
- ✓ 2. The heart of his ministry was proclamation of the Gospel (v. 20)
- ✓ 3. Enemies of the Gospel sought to kill him (v. 21)
- ✓ 4. With God's help proclamation was given to all (v. 22)
- ✓ 5. That proclamation centered on the prophecied Messiah (v. 23)
