The sea voyage segment is from Malta to Puteoli, and then the trip overland from Puteoli to Rome.

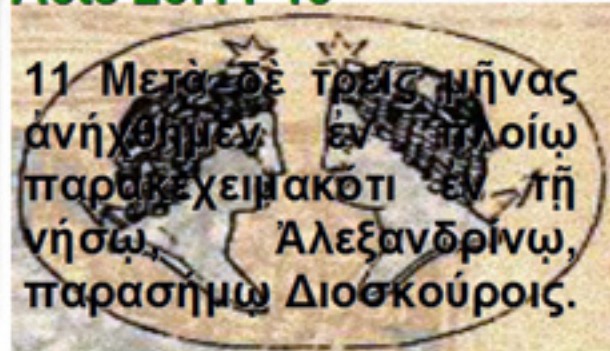

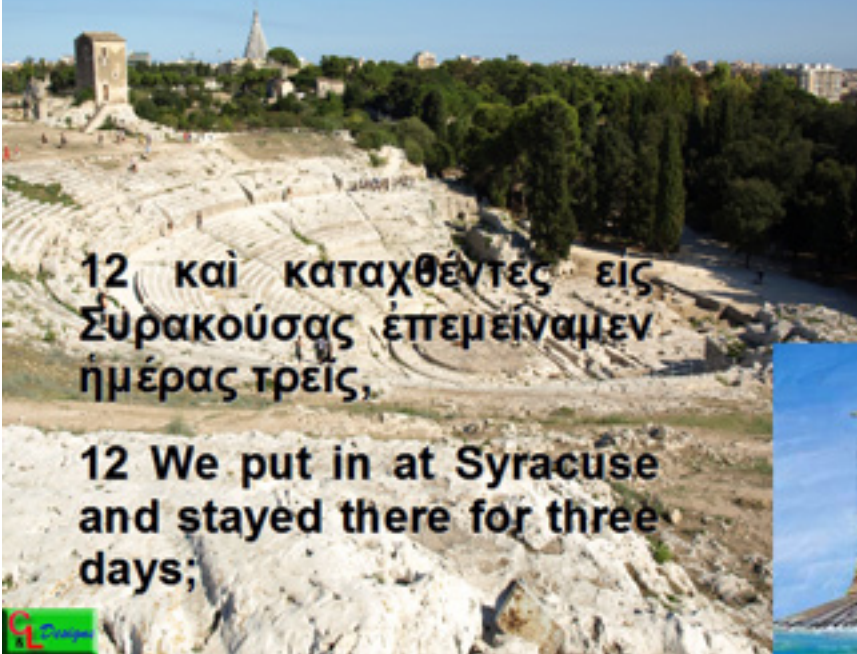
11 Three months later we set sail on a ship that had wintered at the island, an Alexandrian ship with the Twin Brothers as its figurehead.

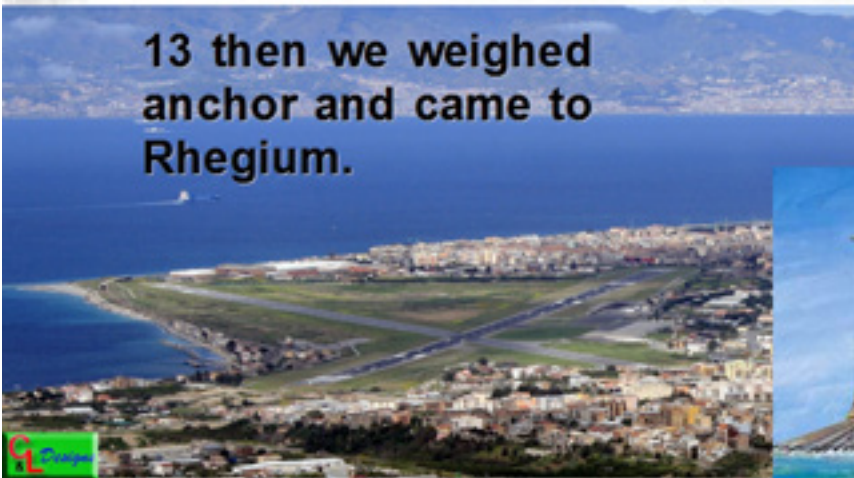

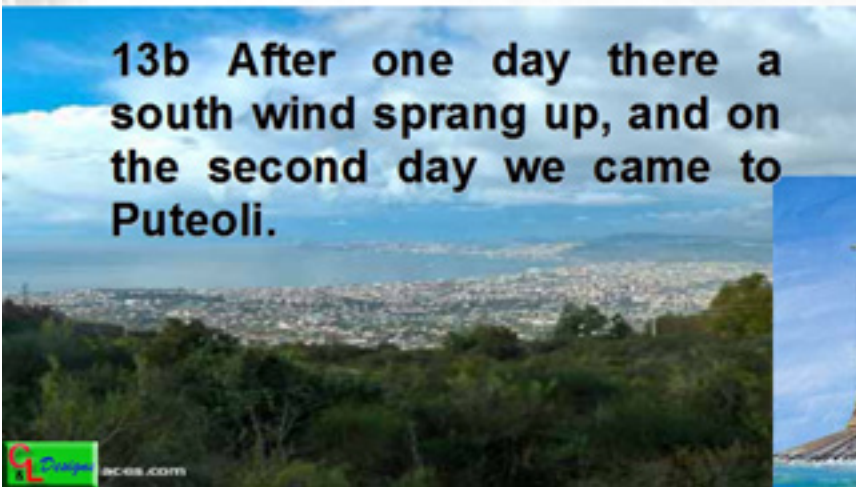

Acts 28:11-15

14 οὗ εὐρόντες ἀδελφοὺς παρεκλήθημεν παρ' αὐτοῖς ἐπιμεῖναι ἡμέρας ἑπτὰ· καὶ οὕτως εἰς τὴν Ῥώμην ἦλθαμεν.

14 There we found believers and were invited to stay with them for seven days. And so we came to Rome.

15 κάκειθεν οἱ ἀδελφοὶ ἀκούσαντες τὰ περὶ ἡμῶν ἦλθαν εἰς ἀπάντησιν ἡμῖν ἄχρι Ἀππίου φόρου καὶ Τριῶν ταβερνῶν, οὓς ἰδὼν ὁ Παῦλος εὐχαριστήσας τῷ θεῷ ἔλαβεν θάρσος.

15 The believers from there, when they heard of us, came as far as the Forum of Appius and Three Taverns to meet us. On seeing them, Paul thanked God and took courage.

- **What can we learn from the trip from Malta to Rome?**
 - ✓ 1. The final leg of Paul's journey was uneventful
 - ✓ 2. Paul was privileged to fellowship with believers at Puteoli
 - ✓ 3. The two groups from Rome that met him on the Appian Way reflected true Christian concern for the apostle.
 - ✓ 4. Paul's seeing them brought him joy and thankfulness
