Thus a chiasmus is created: ab // b' a'. The negative motivation (= a / a') is important but the primary emphasis falls on the positive motivation (= b / b').





Β' οἱ μὲν ἐξ ἀγάπης Α' οἱ δὲ ἐξ...

Thus a chiasmus is created: ab // b' a'. The negative motivation (= a / a') is important but the primary emphasis falls on the positive motivation (= b / b').

17 οἱ δὲ ἐξ ἐριθείας τὸν Χριστὸν καταγγέλλουσιν, οὐχ ἀγνῶς, οἰόμενοι θλίψιν ἐγείρειν τοῖς δεσμοῖς μου.

17 the others proclaim Christ out of selfish ambition, not sincerely but intending to increase my suffering in my imprisonment.



8.1.4.5.1 Opposition at Rome from within, Phil. 1:12-26, pt. 7, v. 18a

18 Τί γάρ; πλὴν ὅτι παντὶ τρόπῳ, εἴτε προφάσει εἴτε ἀληθείᾳ, Χριστὸς καταγγέλλεται, καὶ ἐν τούτῳ χαίρω.

18 What does it matter? Just this, that Christ is proclaimed in every way, whether out of false motives or true; and in that I rejoice.

- **What can we learn from Paul's experience in Rome?**
 - ✓ 1. God turned Paul's arrest into some good
 - ✓ 2. The Gospel impacted Roman officials that otherwise would not have heard the message
 - ✓ 3. Paul's example inspired believers in the church at Rome
 - ✓ 4. Motivations for sharing the Gospel were both good and bad
 - ✓ 5. Paul was happy that the Gospel was being shared
