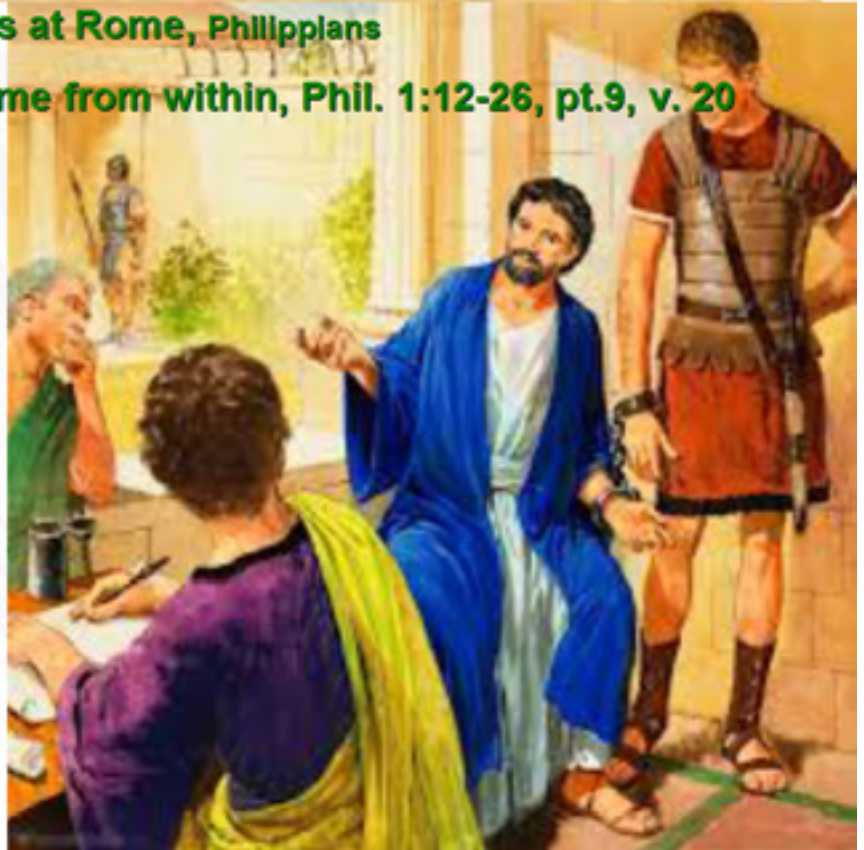

αἰσχυνηθήσομαι ἀλλ' ἐν πάσῃ
παρρησίᾳ ὡς πάντοτε καὶ
νῦν μεγαλυνηθήσεται Χριστὸς
ἐν τῷ σώματί μου, εἴτε διὰ
ζωῆς εἴτε διὰ θανάτου.

20 It is my eager
expectation and hope that
I will not be put to shame
in any way, but that by my
speaking with all
boldness, Christ will be
exalted now as always in
my body, whether by life
or by death.

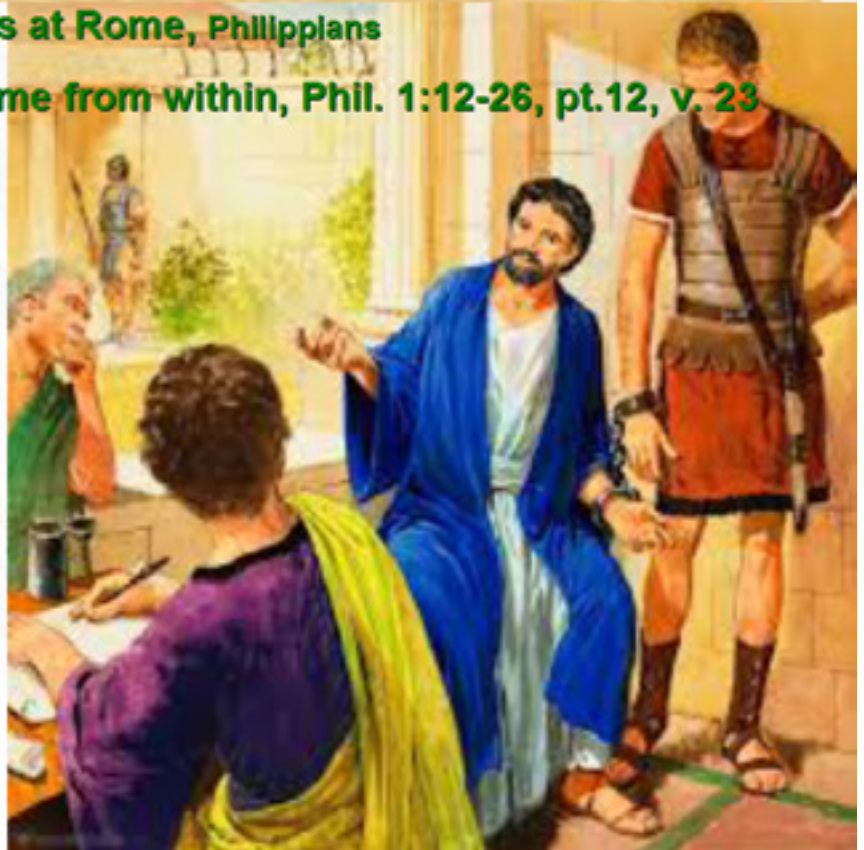

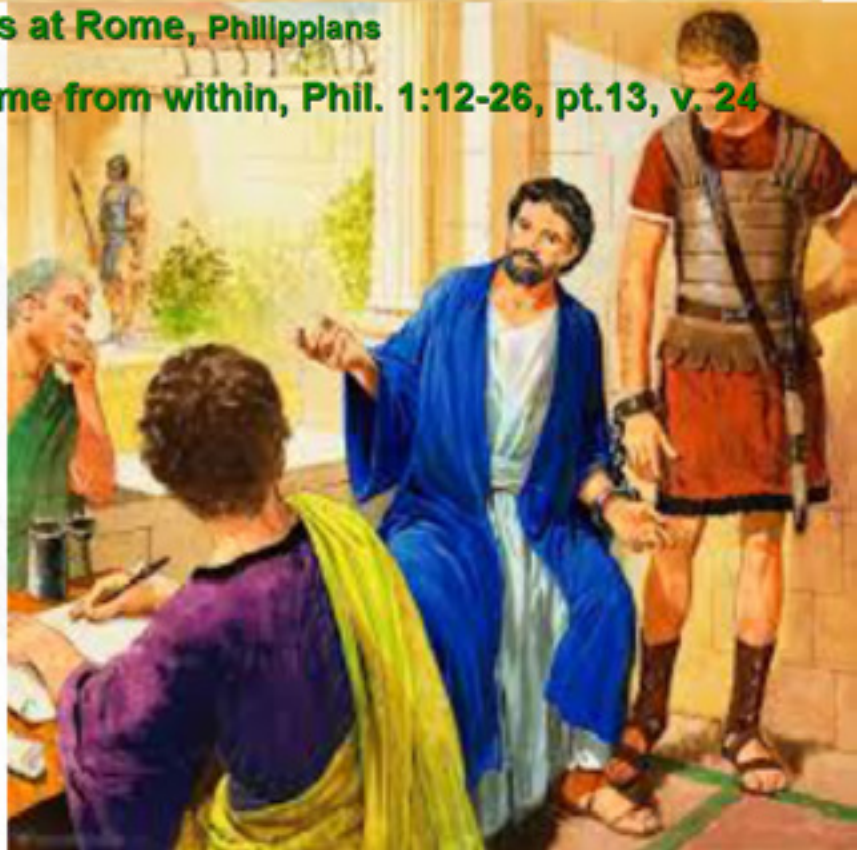

ὑμᾶς.

when I come to you again.

- **What can we learn from Paul's experience in Rome?**
 - ✓ 1. Paul was convinced of God's working through his situation
 - ✓ 2. Paul's deep concern was to honor Christ in his situation
 - ✓ 3. Living or dying presents a win / win situation for believers
 - ✓ 4. Deciding which to desire is not easy
 - ✓ 5. Paul was convinced of the living option for the sake of others
