- **What can we learn from Paul's experience in Rome?**

- ✓ 1. The church at Philippi had women leaders beginning with Lydia
- ✓ 2. Euodia and Synche were leaders
- ✓ 3. Tension developed between these two
- ✓ 4. Paul asks a trusted leader to mediate
- ✓ 5. Conflict can be resolved
