

#### 8.1.6.2 Glimpses of the last days, Pt. 2,

10 Σὺ δὲ παρηκολούθησάς μου τῆ διδασκαλία, τῆ ἀγωγῆ, τῆ προθέσει, τῆ πίστει, τῆ μακροθυμία, τῆ ἀγάπη, τῆ διωγμοῖς, ύπομονῆ. 11 τοῖς TOĨC παθήμασιν, ένένετο Άντιοχεία, έν Ίκονίω, έν Λύστροις, οἴους διωγμούς ύπήνεγκα καὶ ἐκ πάντων με ερρύσατο ο κύριος. 12 καὶ πάντες δὲ οἰ θέλοντες εύσεβῶς ζῆν ἐν Χριστῷ Ἰησοῦ διωχθήσονται. 13 πονηροί δὲ ἄνθρωποι καὶ νόητες προκόψουσιν ἐπὶ τὸ χεῖρον πλανῶντες καὶ πλανώμενοι. 14 Σὺ δὲ μένε έν οίς έμαθες καὶ έπιστώθης, είδὼς παρὰ τίνων ἔμαθες, 15 καὶ ὅτι ἀπὸ βρέφους [τὰ] ἱερὰ γράμματα οίδας, τὰ δυνάμενά σε σοφίσαι είς σωτηρίαν διὰ πίστεως τῆς ἐν Χριστῷ Ἰησοῦ.



10 Now you have observed my teaching, my conduct, my aim in life, my faith, my patience, my love, my steadfastness, 11 my persecutions, and my suffering the things that happened to me in Antioch, Iconium, and Lystra. What persecutions I endured! Yet the Lord rescued me from all of them. 12 Indeed, all who want to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted. 13 But wicked people and impostors will go from bad to worse, deceiving others and being deceived. 14 But as for you, continue in what you have learned and firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it, 15 and how from childhood you have known the sacred writings that are able to instruct you for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.

6 As for me, I am already being poured out as a libation, and the time of my departure has come. 7 I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. 8 From now on there is reserved for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous judge, will give me on that day, and not only to me but also to all who have longed for his appearing.

Μᾶρκον ἀναλαβὼν ἄγε μετά σεαυτοῦ. ἔστιν γάρ HOI εύχρηστος είς διακονίαν. 12 Τύχικον δὲ ἀπέστειλα είς Έφεσον. 13 τὸν φαιλόνην ὂν ἀπέλιπον ἐν Τρωάδι παρὰ Κάρπῳ ἐρχόμενος φέρε, καὶ τὰ βιβλία μάλιστα τὰς μεμβράνας. 14 Άλέξανδρος ο χαλκεὺς πολλά μοι κακὰ ένεδείξατο· ἀποδώσει αὐτῶ ὁ κύριος κατά τὰ ἔργα αὐτοῦ· 15 ὃν καὶ σὺ φυλάσσου, λίαν γὰρ ἀντέστη τοῖς ημετέροις λόγοις.



9 Do your best to come to me soon, 10 for Demas, in love with this present world, has deserted me and gone to Thessalonica; Crescens has gone to Galatia, Titus to Dalmatia. 11 Only Luke is with me. Get Mark and bring him with you, for he is useful in my ministry. 12 I have sent Tychicus to Ephesus. 13 When you come, bring the cloak that I left with Carpus at Troas, also the books, and above all the parchments. 14 Alexander the coppersmith did me great harm; the Lord will pay him back for his deeds. 15 You also must beware of him, for he strongly opposed our message.

16 Έν τῆ πρώτη μου ἀπολογία ούδείς μοι παρεγένετο, άλλὰ πάντες με έγκατέλιπον· μὴ αὐτοῖς λογισθείη· 17 ὁ δὲ κύριός μοι παρέστη καὶ ένεδυνάμωσέν με, δı' έμοῦ ΤÒ κήρυγμα άκούσωσιν πληροφορηθή καὶ πάντα τὰ ἔθνη, καὶ ἐρρύσθην ἐκ στόματος λέοντος. 18 ρύσεταί με ό κύριος ἀπὸ παντὸς ἔργου πονηροῦ καὶ σώσει είς τὴν βασιλείαν αύτοῦ τὴν ἐπουράνιον· ῷ ἡ δόξα εἰς τοὺς αἰῶνας τῶν αἰώνων, ἀμήν.



16 At my first defense no one came to my support, but all deserted me. May it not be counted against them! 17 But the Lord stood by me and gave me strength, so that through me the message might be fully proclaimed and all the Gentiles might hear it. So I was rescued from the lion's mouth. 18 The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and save me for his heavenly kingdom. To him be the glory forever and ever. Amen.

19 "Ασπασαι Πρίσκαν καὶ Ἀκύλαν καὶ τὸν Ὁνησιφόρου οἶκον. 20 Έραστος ἔμεινεν ἐν Κορίνθω, Τρόφιμον δὲ ἀπέλιπον ἐν Μιλήτω ἀσθενοῦντα. 21 Σπούδασον πρὸ χειμῶνος ἐλθεῖν. Ἀσπάζεταί σε Εὔβουλος καὶ Πούδης καὶ Λίνος καὶ Κλαυδία καὶ οἱ ἀδελφοὶ πάντες.



19 Greet Prisca and Aquila, and the household of Onesiphorus. 20 Erastus remained in Corinth; Trophimus I left ill in Miletus. 21 Do your best to come before winter. Eubulus sends greetings to you, as do Pudens and Linus and Claudia and all the brothers and sisters.
