How and what did Jesus teach? The four gospels present His teaching largely around the concept of $\tau \tilde{\eta} \varsigma \beta \alpha \sigma \iota \lambda \epsilon (\alpha \varsigma \tau \sigma \tilde{\upsilon} \theta \epsilon \sigma \tilde{\upsilon})$, the Kingdom of God. We will explore the meaning of this idea.

Jesus' fundamental mission in this world was to provide God's salvation for all humanity. How He did this will be our concluding topic.
