**Day Two: Revelation 2:1-11** Τόδε λέγει:

2.1: Τὸ ἀγγέλω τῆς ἐν Ἐφέσῳ ἐκκλησίας γράψον· Τάδε λέγει ὁ κρατῶν τοὺς ἑπτὰ ἀστέρας ἐν τῇ δεξιᾷ αὐτοῦ, ὁ περιπατῶν ἐν μέσῳ τῶν ἑπτὰ λυχνιῶν τῶν χρυσοῦν·

2 I know your works, your affliction and your patient endurance, I know that you cannot tolerate evildoers, you have tested those who claim to be apostles but are not, and have found them to be false, 3 I also know that you are enduring patiently and bearing up for the sake of my name, and that you have not grown weary, 4 But I have this against you, that you have abandoned the love you had at first.

**Day Two: Revelation 2:1-11**

2.5 μνημόνευε οὖν πῶθεν πεπίπκας καὶ μετανοήσον καὶ τὰ πρῶτα ἔργα ποιήσον· ἢ ἴσθι μὴ ἔρχομαι σοὶ καὶ κλησῶ τὴν λυχνίαν σου ἐκ τοῦ τόπου αὐτῆς, ἂν μὴ μετανόησῃς· ἢ ἀλλὰ τοῦτο ἔχεις ἐπιμοιῆς τὰ ἔργα τῶν Νικολαίων ὃ κἀγὼ μισῶ.

2.10 μὴδὲν φοβοῦ ὃ μέλλεις πάσχειν· ἰδοὺ μέλλει βάλλειν ὁ διάβολος ἐξ ὠμῶν εἰς φυλακὴν ἵνα πειρασθῆτε καὶ ἴζητε θλίψιν ἡμερῶν δέκα· γίνου πιστὸς ἄχρι θανάτου, καὶ δώσω σοὶ τὸν στέφανον τῆς ζωῆς.

2.5 Remember then from what you have fallen; repent, and do the works you did at first. If not, I will come to you and remove your lampstand from its place, unless you repent. 6 Yet this is to your credit: you hate the works of the Nicolaitans, which I also hate.

2.10 Do not fear what you are about to suffer. Beware, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison so that you may be tested, and for ten days you will have affliction. Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life.
