Welcome to Rev. Kurt Steinhart

We welcome to our service today Bro. Steinhart. He is no stranger to our church and has preached in this pulpit previously. Earlier he shared this background information with Pastor Lorin:

Since 40 years I have been following Jesus Christ and for 38 years I have been in the full-time-ministry. I spent 3 years in a Bible school and 4 years with Operation Mobilisation in Belgien, Austria, England and India. Since 1979 I have been with the Open Air Campaigners Germany - Freiversammlungsmission. Our ministry is among foreigners and Germans to bring them to the Lord Jesus Christ. We start new House-Meetings-Churches amongst Afrikans, Arabic speaking and Sri Lanka - tamil speaking people. In the last 5 years we - together with my wife - went to Sri Lanka, India and Ukraine and myself with a Team to Litauen for teaching about Open-Air-Preaching and going out with church people to do evangelism. Also for Bible teaching und evangelistic ministry. We have four children and 2 grandchildren. Our son is also in fulltime service as an evangelist with the Janz Team.
