## Prayer List<sup>1</sup> IBC Baptist Church of Cologne as of 30 November 2008

He [Jesus] was teaching and saying, "Is it not written, "My house shall be called a house of prayer for all the nations'?" (Mark 11:17)

The following indicates individuals and situations that we as members of the International Baptist Church in Cologne need to be praying for daily.

- Calvin and Betty Ann Hogue. Pastor, we pledge to pray for God's blessings on your leadership of the church in the coming months.
- For the special World Worship Sunday on Dec. 7.
- For possible mission projects next summer. The International Baptist Convention has entered into a partnership agreement with the Virginia Baptist Convention for joint mission ventures. Beginning conversations have taken place between Pastor Lorin and Craig Waddell, mission projects coordinator for the VBMB, about a mission group for sometime in June or July of 2009. Be much in prayer for God's guidance into how we can partner with Virginia Baptists in outreach activities to win people to Christ in our city.
- Pastor Lorin and Claire as they are in the process of selling their home in North Carolina and preparing for the move to Germany in December. Individuals have begun looking at our home with the guidance of real estate agents. Pray that God will send a buyer soon. *Our return trip to Germany is now booked for a flight from Charlotte to Frankfurt on Dec. 29 with arrival Tuesday morning, Dec. 30.* Thanks to everyone praying for our health. Everything continues to progress nicely now as I adjust to the new combination of medicines.
- For former members of IBC church Cologne, that many of them will find God leading them to return to active service in our church. We rejoice over those whom God has led to reunite with our church already this fall.
- For national leaders around the world as they try to come to grips with the deepening economic troubles world wide. In the past such difficulties have often preceded major wars. Pray that God will intervene to give wisdom for solving these problems quickly and without violent conflict developing.
- For the world wide ministries of Christ to the World Ministries (CTTWM). Pastor Lorin has served for several years as biblical and theological editor, as well as writer, for this Texas based organization that broadcasts radio dramas and Bible studies to over 100 million people scattered all the way from Russia to China and Korea. Broadcasts over most of India began on July 6 and will continue for several months. I'm now editing several manuscripts on Bible studies in the Book of Acts in preparation for broadcast beginning in early 2009.
- For the Russian Christians and specifically for the Far East Broadcasting (FEBC). CTTWM re-

cently received word from the FEBC National Director Rudi Wiens of growing concerns that he has. We have partnered with Rudi for the past 3 years in our broadcasts to the Russian people. In the past twenty years he cannot remember such a challenging time for their broadcast ministry. We need to pray for Rudi, Victor, and the entire staff in Moscow and St. Petersburg. They face many pressures both political and financial. With inflation hitting so hard in the large cities, it is putting additional financial strain on them at FEBC. Also pray that God will change the hearts of the leaders in Russia. We all know that all things are possible through God who gives us strength. On a positive note, we just learned that we have the green light to broadcast via Satellite and our Internet broadcasts are expanding in Russia. Although more expensive, we will reach hundreds of thousands of everyday people where they live and in ways they can understand through our programs.
