# Prayer List<sup>1</sup>

IBC Baptist Church of Cologne as of 1 February 2009 He [Jesus] was teaching and saying, "Is it not written, "My house shall be called a house of prayer for all the nations'?" (Mark 11:17)

The following indicates individuals and situations that we as members of the International Baptist Church in Cologne need to be praying for daily.

- For possible mission projects next summer. The International Baptist Convention has entered into a partnership agreement with the Virginia Baptist Convention for joint mission ventures. Beginning conversations have taken place between Pastor Lorin and Craig Waddell, mission projects coordinator for the VBMB, about a mission group for sometime in June or July of 2009. Be much in prayer for God's guidance into how we can partner with Virginia Baptists in outreach activities to win people to Christ in our city.
- For Joe Phiri, who is recovering from surgery this week at the Universitätsklinikum.
- For President Barack Obama of the United States as he assumes leadership of that country and begins impacting other countries around the world.
- For national leaders around the world as they try to come to grips with the deepening
  economic troubles world wide. In the past such difficulties have often preceded major
  wars. Pray that God will intervene to give wisdom for solving these problems quickly and
  without violent conflict developing.
- For the world wide ministries of Christ to the World Ministries (CTTWM). Pastor Lorin has
  served for several years as biblical and theological editor, as well as writer, for this Texas
  based organization that broadcasts radio dramas and Bible studies to over 100 million
  people scattered all the way from Russia to China and Korea.
- For Norman Bridges, a member of the Sunday School class at First Baptist Church, Shelby,
  NC. Norman had a growth on his spine removed surgically last week, and the prognosis
  is that he will never be able to walk again because of the nerve damage. The report the
  latter part of this week is encouraging that he will not experience full paralysis.
- For our church as we move into a new year with many exciting plans for growth and outreach to our city.
- For the finance team who is working on a proposed budget to be presented to the church
  at the middle of February for its consideration and approval. The process is moving along
  with the Church Council considering the budget during the first weeks of February, and
  then the church adopting a budget by the end of February.
- For God's peace to reign in the war torn country of Zimbabwe.
- For the ProChrist crusade coming up March 29 April 5. People all over Germany will have the opportunity to hear the Gospel message presented by Ulrich Parzany, a former leader of the YMCA in Germany.

- For the country of Costa Rica that suffered a very destructive earth quake on Jan. 8. Here
  is a letter from Pastor Ron Tucker:

Greetings from IBC in Costa Rica. I'm addressing this to leaders of a number of churches abroad who are unaware of our disaster here, and have been unable to help us because they don't know the need. Please pass it on to your pastor or the appropriate leadership and pray with us here that God will lead all of us to do great things for Him. This, then, is information, and a request as well for intervention. God's people always respond well to known needs.

Members of San Jose's International Baptist Church yesterday toured some of the devastated area from the 6.2 earthquake of January 8. Twenty-three bodies have been recovered, many are still missing. More than 425 homes were totally destroyed, and over 2000 people are in makeshift shelters, many in tent cities. Total damage is estimated at over \$100 000 000.00 US dollars. One highway has to be rerouted.

We zeroed in on the Fraijanes area where Pastor Roy Soto of the Shalom Church and 8 or 10 other area pastors have taken charge of the relief work. Lots of goods have been received there and our carload added to them, but to our great surprise, the money we could offer, about \$300, was the first money they had received at all!
