==============MOTHER'S DAY RECOGNITION==================

"The modern Mother's Day is celebrated on various days in many parts of the world, most commonly in May, though also in March, as a day to honor mothers and motherhood. In the UK and Ireland it follows the old traditions of Mothering Sunday." The origins of the celebration reach far back in western civilization, perhaps as early to ancient Greece and Rome where female deities were worshipped in honor of motherhood. In Christianized Europe Laetare Sunday, the 4th Sunday in Lent, honors Mary, 'the mother of the church.' Mothering Sunday is has been celebrated in the Church of England since the sixteenth century. In the US, Mother's Day was originally a pacifist reaction to the American Civil War and the Franco-Prussian war. In 1912 at the insistence of Anna Jarvis. Mother's Day was proclaimed a civil holiday in the US by President Woodrow Wilson. The celebration has grown signficantly so that in the US it typically is the third highest church attendance day of the year. Most countries that celebrate Mother's Day do so on the second Sunday of May, but many other dates are used by many countries for slightly different celebrations of motherhood.
